More than 181,000 Californians are experiencing homelessness, often related to mental health crises and substance use. Prop. 1 issues \$6.4 billion in bonds. Money will go to building 4,350 supportive housing units, with 2,350 set aside for veterans, and facilities holding 6,800 mental health and substance use treatment places.
